Position Summary:

Performs all tasks involved in the production of the company's products. Repetitive manufacturing of products such as erosion control blankets and wattles in a fast-paced industrial organization. Reports to Production Supervisor. FLSA Status is Non-Exempt.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Assume certain duties and be a backup for the production supervisor as needed.
- Safely operate the incinerator (loading, unloading & clean out).
- Be able to successfully perform shipping/receiving duties to include all finished goods and raw materials (outbound and inbound).
- Perform all the duties below to include every machine in the facility efficiently & effectively.
- Product fabrication to make full line of company products.
- Starts production machinery & equipment at beginning of the shift (as necessary).
- Monitors equipment to ensure that products are being assembly properly and to quality standards.
- Makes any setting adjustments as necessary to ensure quality and required parameters are met (weights lengths, etc.)
- Monitors the quality of each item/roll produced and removes any rejected products from the line.
- Verify the attachment of appropriate labels to products and packages.
- Package product and stack into correct pallet formation.
- Set up, change over, load, operate, tear-down, clean, troubleshoot, and make minor adjustments to equipment.
- Track, maintain, and review all required records such as production and product data for quality specifications.
- Complete daily checks of all equipment in assigned work area.
- Notify supervisor of any mechanical, material issues, quality or safety issues.
- Adhere to all safety practices, plant rules, company rules, regulations, and policies.
- Always maintain proper housekeeping in work area as well as keep equipment clean and orderly.
- Train and direct any assigned utility workers to ensure maximum efficiencies in all tasks of producing products.
- Work at different work stations as production needs require.
- Be able to successfully attain a company MHE certification to operate company MHE (forklift, clamp truck, skid loader) efficiently and safely to stage and move finished product and raw materials.

Supervisory Responsibilities:

• Assist the Production Supervisor in the leadership, training and day to day operation of the production department to reach and or exceed are company goals and standards.
